MEDIUM WALK on TUESDAY 5th DECEMBER 2023

MEET at *10.00* in the car park in front of Lady Lever Art Gallery (CH62 5EQ). Or 09.30 at Station Road Car Park, Neston if a lift is required.

DISTANCE: 4.3 miles

Route Outline:

The walk starts at the Lady Lever Art Gallery where there is plenty of free parking and toilets in the Gallery Cafe, which opens at 10am.

The walk takes us through the picturesque village of Port Sunlight and on to the Port Sunlight River Park trail. The trail route is largely built on a former landfill site and the methane produced from the underground decaying products is now being extracted. On a clear day there are some excellent views across the river Mersey to Liverpool and over to the welsh hills.

Following the walk, refreshments can be obtained at either the Gallery Café or The Bridge Inn (open to the public from 8am and they do serve coffee but perhaps not cakes/biscuits), assuming members of the car-sharing groups agree.
