



MEDIUM WALK on TUESDAY 1st July 2025

MEET at 09:30 at Station Road Car Park, Neston to organise car sharing or 10:00 am at Hadlow Road Station Car Park, Willaston.

DISTANCE: 3.5 miles

From Hadlow Road Station the walk will go along the Wirral Way as far as Heath Lane where we will then walk up to Hooton Road and cross over into Street Hey Lane. At the end of Street Hey Lane a narrow footpath will take us along field edges until we reach stone steps at the junction of the footpath to Raby. Here we turn left to walk down to Benty Heath Lane. Turning right we walk a short distance until just past the Old Mill before turning left onto a footpath to take us across fields, past Jackson's Pond and into Willaston. The route will return to Hadlow Road Station via the main roads.

There are no footpaths along Heath Lane or Street Hey Lane. There are no stiles – they have been replaced by gates.
