

WALKS



MEDIUM WALK on TUESDAY 4th August 2026

MEET at 09:30 at Station Road Car Park, Neston to organise car sharing or 10:00 am at the former Pollard Inn's carpark, Willaston (parking at Hadlow Road is likely to be busier due to school holidays)

DISTANCE: 3.5 miles

From the carpark the walk will go into Willaston Village and pick up the footpath to the right of the churchyard. The footpath leads to Jackson's Pond and onwards towards Big Meadow. Turning right we will pass through three kissing-gates before reaching Mill Road. Turning right, the route leads us towards and past the Mill before crossing the road to pick up a track signposted to Raby. When we reach the stone steps on the right, we climb them and pass through a kissing-gate, to take the footpath along field edges. After passing through three more kissing-gates and crossing, via old railway sleepers, footbridges we turn right onto a path which leads into Street Hey Lane. On reaching the junction with Hooton Road we will cross and walk along Heath Lane to the turning for the Wirral Way. From here the walk takes us back to Hadlow Road Station and onwards to the carpark.

There are no footpaths along Heath Lane or Street Hey Lane.
