MEDIUM WALK on TUESDAY 6th October 2026

Meet at **09:30** in car park at Station Road, Neston, to arrange car sharing. Or at **10.00** in the car park at the junction of Pasture Road and Leasowe Road.

DISTANCE: 4.5 or 5 miles (depending on whether the final half mile is undertaken).

River Birket - Leasowe Castle

From the carpark we head inland along Pasture Road to join the Wirral Circular Trail that runs alongside the Birket towards Bidston. When we reach Bidston Golf Course we cross over the river and cut through the housing estate to pick up a path crossing playing fields. We will cross Leasowe Road and walk up Telegraph Lane to join the coastal path adjacent to Wallasey Golf Club. We then walk along the embankment (now part of the King Charles 111 England Coastal Path) back to the car park, passing Leasowe Golf Course and Leasowe Castle. There is an option to walk to Leasowe Lighthouse at the end.

The route is predominantly flat with no stiles or gates. There are steps from the car park up to/down from the sea wall. Part of the riverbank route can be muddy if there has been rain recently.

There are toilets (not free) at the entrance to the carpark.

If you need directions to the start point then please let me know.
